### **Loveys sets the record straight**

You may have recently received a flyer from your Conservative MP, Gord Brown, asking if recently arrived immigrants should qualify to receive the Old Age Security pension after 3 years in Canada. The flyer, although carefully worded, leaves the impression that the Liberals are promoting this bill to extend OAS payments to recent immigrants.
